ADEKA FOODS (ASIA) Obtains Halal Certification in Malaysia

We are pleased to announce that the halal certification body of the Malaysian government has certified processed oil products manufactured by ADEKA FOODS (ASIA), a Malaysian subsidiary of ADEKA Corp. (Representative Director and President: Akio Kohri), as halal foods—which are foods complying with Muslim law.

This halal certification has enabled the subsidiary to distribute margarine, shortening and other processed oil products that people in Muslim countries can use without fear of violating Muslim law. The subsidiary plans to start shipping halal products as early as December 2014 and is aiming to achieve sales of four billion yen at an early stage.

The food division of the ADEKA Group will expand sales in Asia and accelerate overseas business development by providing new value to our local customers through cooperation among our operational bases in Japan, China, Singapore and Malaysia.
